Kenai Peninsula Borough exports \$18 million in goods to Canada annually

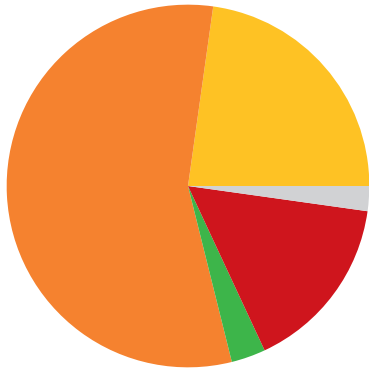
