Kodiak Island Borough exports \$19 million in goods to Canada annually

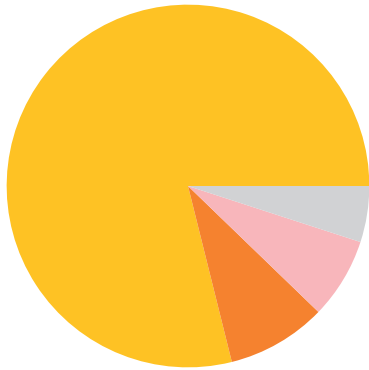
