Apache County exports **\$152 million** in goods to Canada annually

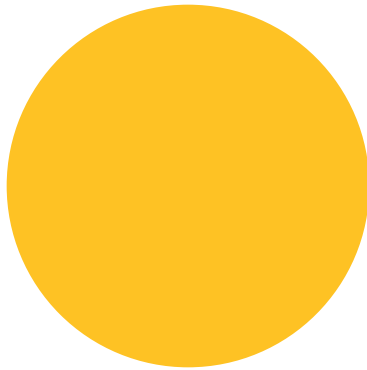
