**Yuma County exports \$81 million in goods to Canada annually**

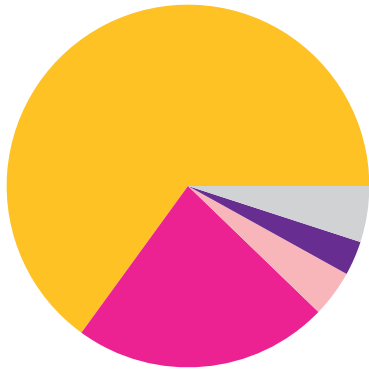
## Top Yuma County goods exports to Canada
