Douglas County exports \$15 million in goods to Canada annually

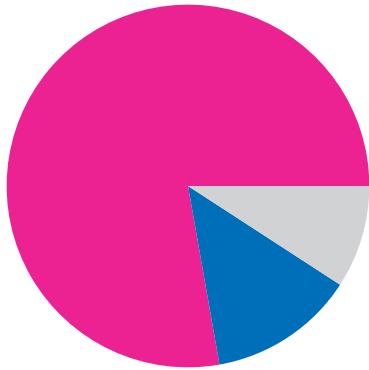
