Chatham County exports \$352 million in goods to Canada annually

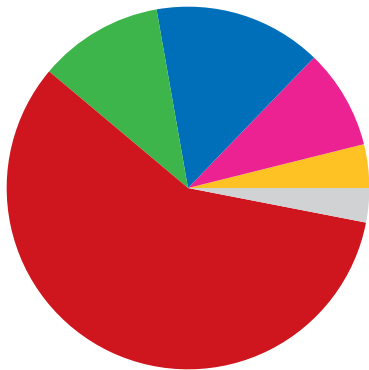
Top Chatham County goods exports to Canada

- Aerospace Products & Parts..... \$176 million
- Ag. & Construction Machinery.....\$51 million
- Pulp & Paperboard Mill Products.....\$37 million
- Motor Vehicles.....\$27 million
- Basic Chemicals.....\$18 million

Chatham County exports \$79 million in services to Canada annually

Top Chatham County services exports to Canada

- Travel (including for education)..... \$37 million
- Charges for the use of intellectual property..\$14 million
- Business services.....\$13 million
- Financial services.....\$6 million
- Telecommunications, computer & information services\$6 million
