Cobb County exports \$262 million in goods to Canada annually

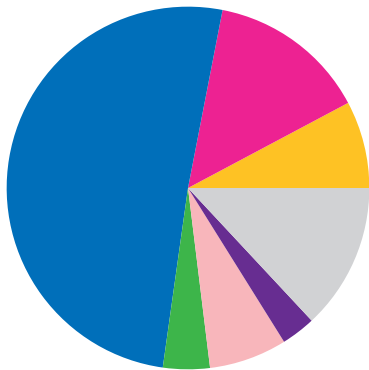
