**Macon County exports \$614 million in goods to Canada annually**

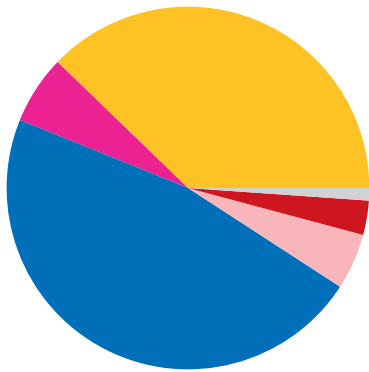
