Peoria County exports **\$1.1 billion** in goods to Canada annually

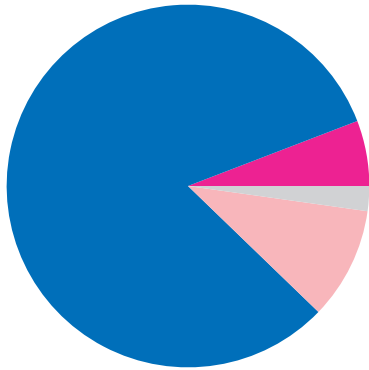
