Hancock County exports **\$69 million** in goods to Canada annually

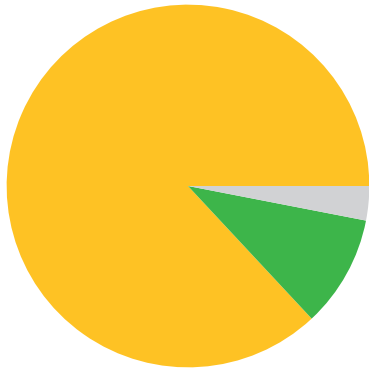
