**Kennebec County exports \$66 million in goods to Canada annually**

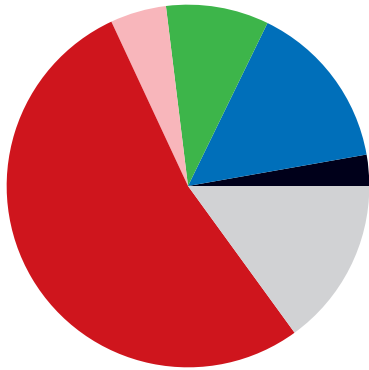
