Calhoun County exports \$573 million in goods to Canada annually

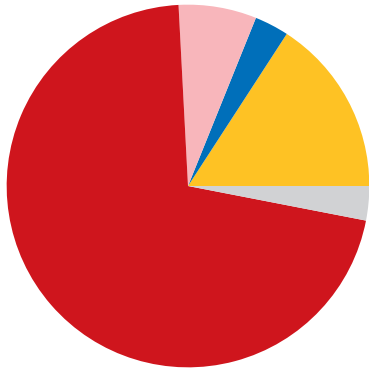
