St. Joseph County exports \$550 million in goods to Canada annually

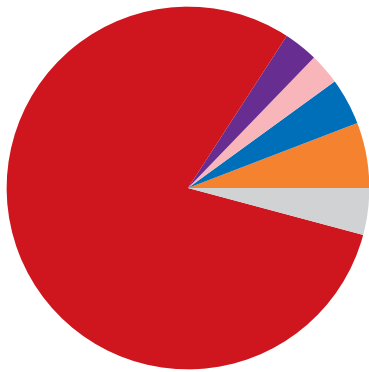
