Ramsey County exports \$353 million in goods to Canada annually

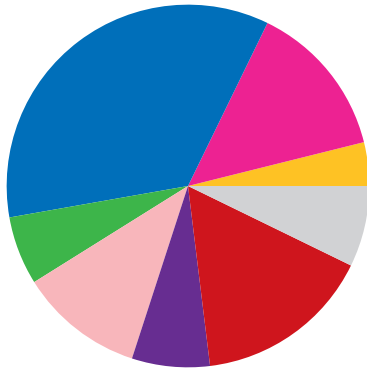
