Lee County exports **\$108 million** in goods to Canada annually

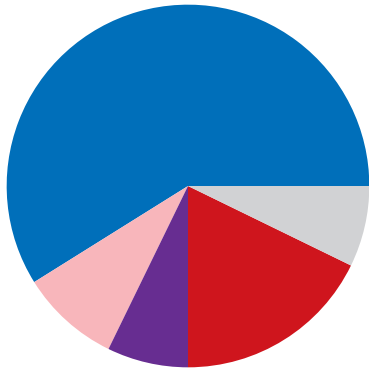
