Monroe County exports \$104 million in goods to Canada annually

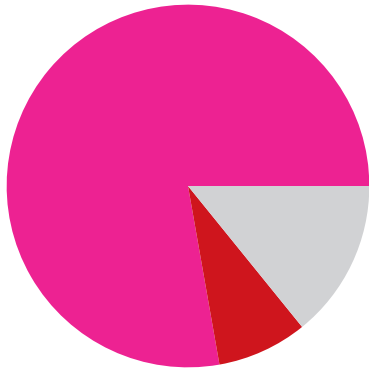
Top Monroe County goods exports to Canada
