Pitt County exports \$285 million in goods to Canada annually

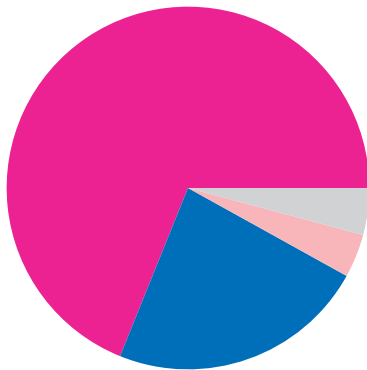
