Cass County exports \$1.0 billion in goods to Canada annually

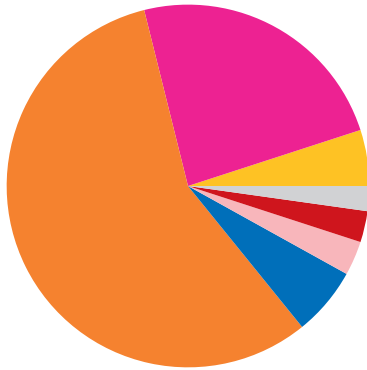
