Dodge County exports \$53 million in goods to Canada annually

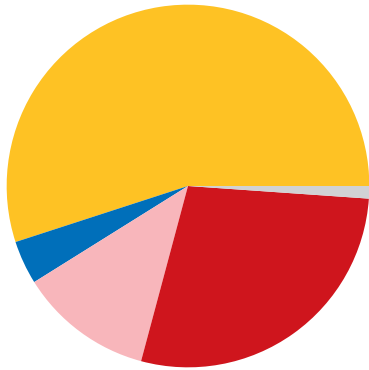
