Rockingham County exports **\$187 million** in goods to Canada annually

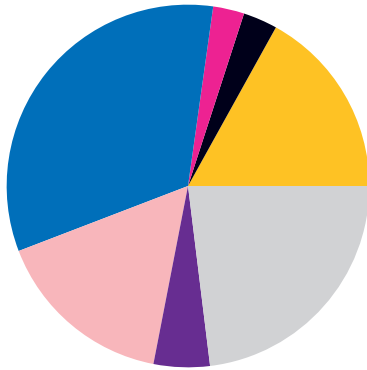
