Lea County exports **\$4 million** in goods to Canada annually

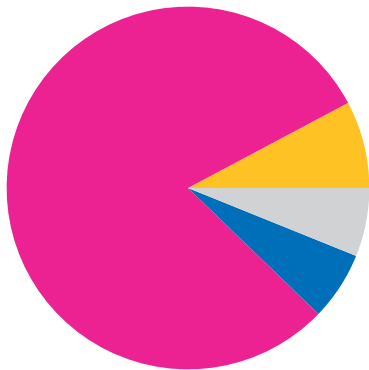
