Kings County exports \$257 million in goods to Canada annually

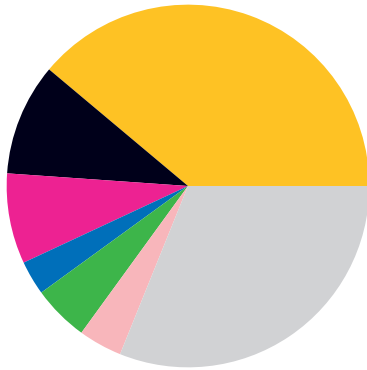
