Onondaga County exports \$378 million in goods to Canada annually

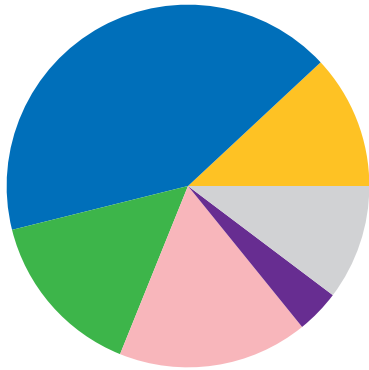
