Lucas County exports **\$1.0 billion** in goods to Canada annually

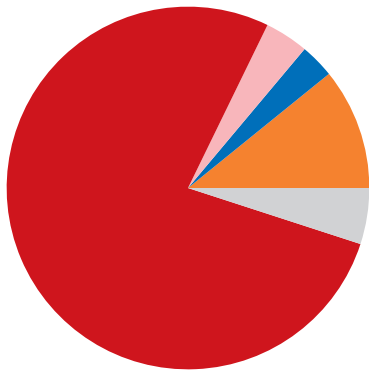
