Comanche County exports \$35 million in goods to Canada annually

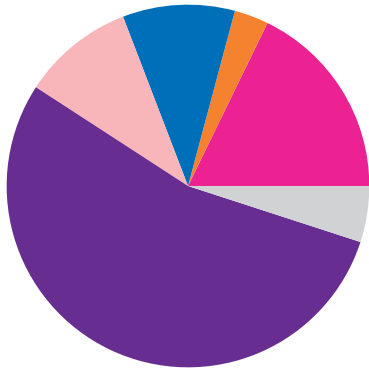
