Kay County exports \$43 million in goods to Canada annually

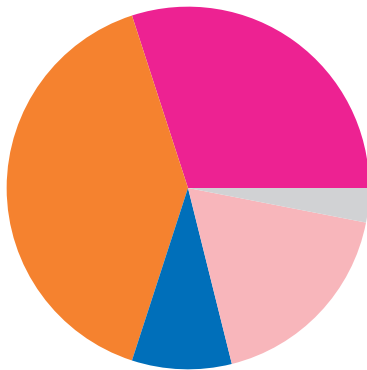
