Rogers County exports \$101 million in goods to Canada annually

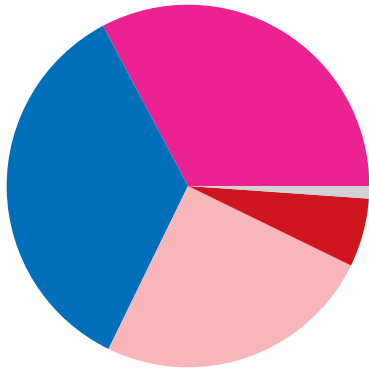
