Clackamas County exports \$352 million in goods to Canada annually

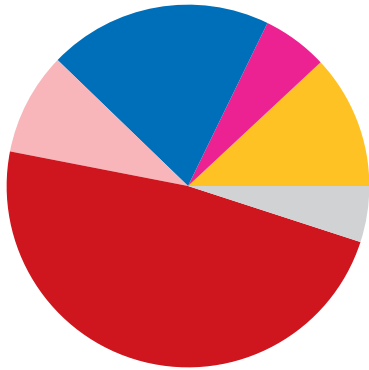
