Linn County exports \$141 million in goods to Canada annually

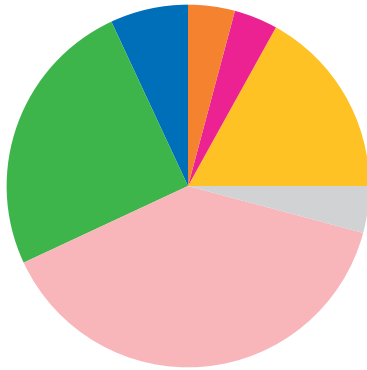
