Orangeburg County exports **\$146 million** in goods to Canada annually

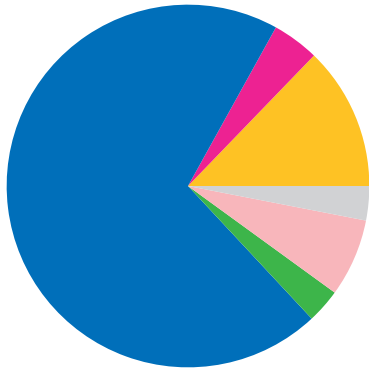
