**Spartanburg County exports \$852 million in goods to Canada annually**

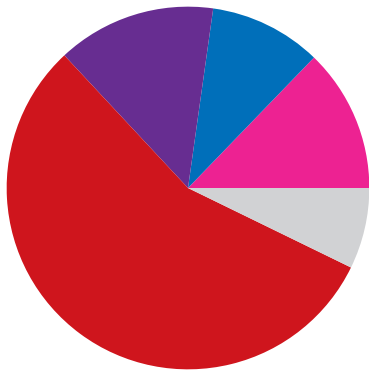
## Top Spartanburg County goods exports to Canada
