Iron County exports **\$46 million** in goods to Canada annually

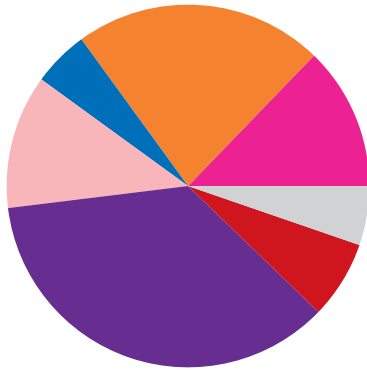
