Lamoille County exports \$23 million in goods to Canada annually

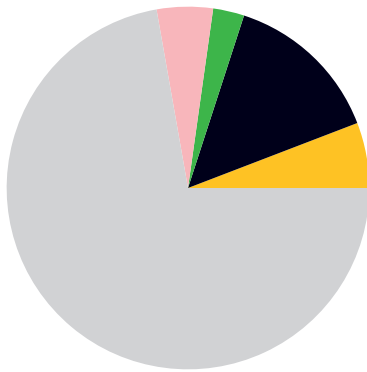
