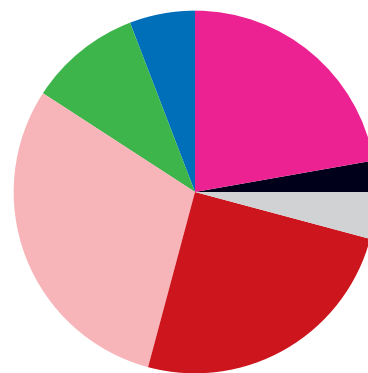
Exports to Canada support 1,750 jobs in AL-1
