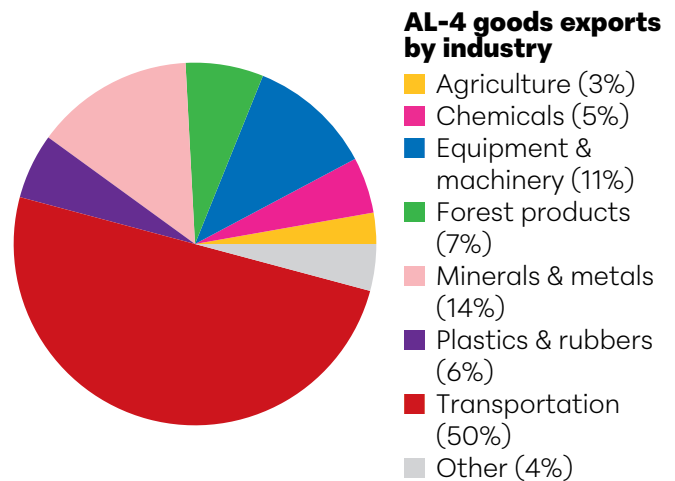
Exports to Canada support 3,400 jobs in AL-4
