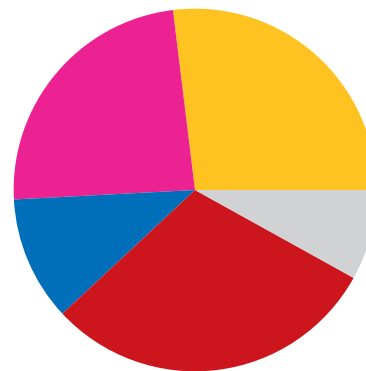
Exports to Canada support 1,700 jobs in FL-11
