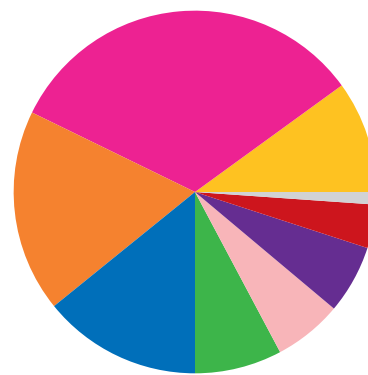
Exports to Canada support 1,450 jobs in LA-5
