## An integrated economy

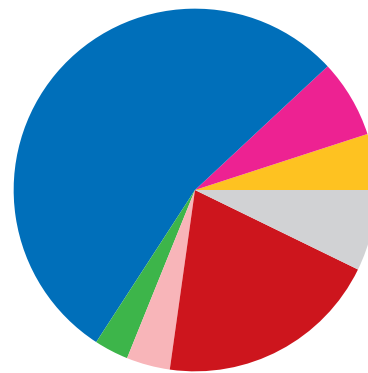
6,610 people are employed at the 61 Canadian-owned businesses operating in NC-14
