## An integrated economy

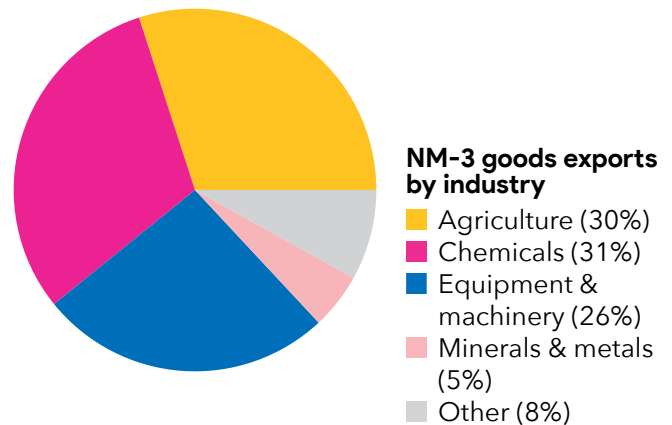
540 people are employed at the 23 Canadian-owned businesses operating in NM-3
