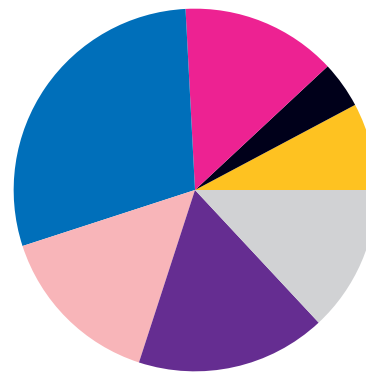
100 people are employed at the 12 Canadian-owned businesses operating in UT-4

UT-4 exports \$203 million in goods to Canada annually

Top UT-4 goods exports to Canada

Plastics Products.....	\$33 million
Ag. & Construction Machinery.....	\$25 million
Medical Equipment & Supplies.....	\$10 million
Basic Chemicals.....	\$7 million
Pesticides & Fertilizers.....	\$7 million
