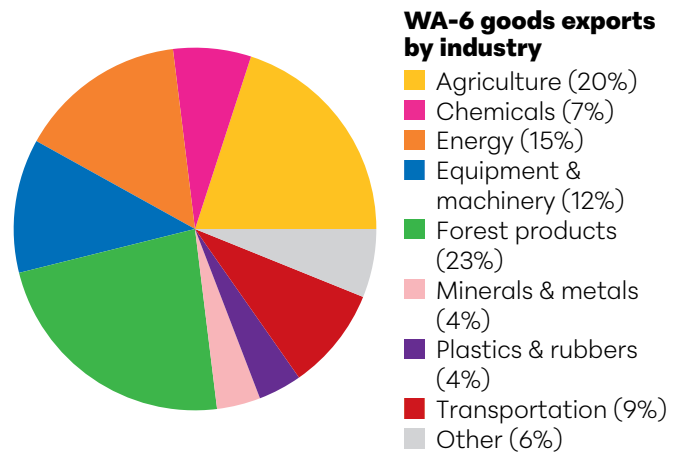
4,430 people are employed at the 45 Canadian-owned businesses operating in WA-6
