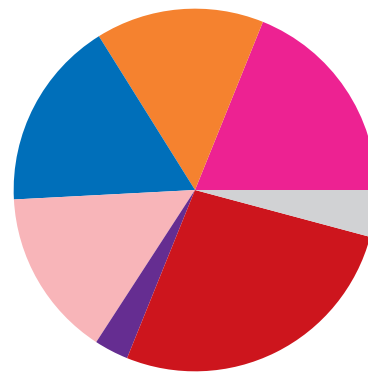

**exports \$745 million**  
 in goods to Canada annually

#### Top WV-2 goods exports to Canada

■ Motor Vehicle Parts.....	\$154 million
■ Engines & turbines.....	\$85 million
■ Petroleum & coal products.....	\$70 million
■ Resins & Synthetic Fibers.....	\$59 million
■ Basic Chemicals.....	\$46 million
