

Canada partnering with the U.S. on a key defense purchase

Canada's strategic defence procurement not only strengthens U.S.-Canada national security and defense cooperation but also creates well-paying jobs in Washington. **Boeing**'s key manufacturing facility in Renton will produce the 16 **P-8A Poseidon Multi Mission Aircraft** for the \$5.9 billion recent purchase by the Government of Canada. This deal further fosters the supply chain integration and innovation collaboration between the U.S. and Canada, as Canada remains Boeing's key supply chain partner and destination of its new innovation center. The P-8A Poseidon will be Canada's new maritime patrol aircraft and will enable our two countries to jointly patrol our shared waters and the Canadian north enabling Canada to fully support NORAD's operations well into the future!



Soaring to new innovative heights

Harbour Air, headquartered in Vancouver, B.C., has been playing an important role in cross-border transportation in the U.S. Pacific Northwest by operating its signature seaplanes between key ports in Washington and British Columbia. Since 2019, Harbour Air has partnered with the Washington-based company MagniX, a leading electric motor manufacturer in Everett, to successfully fly the world's first electric fleet prototype, the eBeaver. This Washington State-Canada collaboration showcases the advancement of the passenger air transportation industry and cements Cascadia as one of the leading regions for innovation and sustainable aviation. The eBeaver project will create employment opportunities for Americans and contribute to the American economy.
