CANADA AS A CUSTOMER: UNITED STATES FOREIGN MILITARY SALES

The **U.S. Foreign Military Sales (FMS)** program is a government-to-government program through which the U.S. Government sells conventional military weapons, equipment, and services to allied and friendly nations to strengthen defense relations and enhance interoperability with U.S. forces.

As a strategic ally, Canada's procurement of U.S. FMS goods and services plays a critical role in strengthening both nations' military capabilities while fostering a robust **economic and defense relationship**.

Canadian acquisitions from the U.S. FMS program have **increased by 281%** over the past 7 years, reaching a record **\$14.5B USD** in active procurement. This growth directly fuels the U.S. defense industrial base, creating jobs, driving technological innovation, and stimulating economic activity across America's defense sector.

This surge in investment has **tripled the number of active procurements over \$100M USD** and underscores Canada's commitment to **high-value**, **high-impact** acquisitions that further strengthen the U.S.-Canada defense relationship.
