

ART GALLERY INFORMATION AND OBJECTIVES

The Embassy's Art Gallery is a key part of our cultural diplomacy programming and offers public exhibitions that reflect Canada's values and excellence in creativity. The Art Gallery is located within the public space of the Embassy and is accessible Monday to Friday between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm. The Embassy of Canada is the only foreign mission on Pennsylvania Avenue NW between the Capitol and the White House. We host numerous events annually, for visiting ministers, diplomatic and military functions, events with partner organizations and to mark milestones or national holidays (e.g., Presidential inaugurations, Canaday Day, Remembrance Day). During such events, distinguished guests are invited to visit our gallery exhibitions.

Our objectives with the Art Gallery are to:

- create a space that reflects Canada as innovative, diverse, and creative while representing all regions and peoples across the country;
- offer a welcoming, accessible space that projects Canadian values through art; and
- highlight important and current themes and priorities for the Government of Canada in areas such as:
 - Gender Equality; Diversity and Inclusion (including anti-racism and 2SLGBTQI+ rights);
 - Human Rights;
 - Indigenous Communities & Reconciliation;
 - Environment and Climate Change; and
 - Peace and Security around the world.
